

Language, Literacy and Communication



During the year we will be concentrating on getting each child to speak and write descriptively, independently and confidently in Welsh and English in a Cross-Curricular manner.


Make consistent use of 'SpellBlast' on Hwb. There will be weekly spellings added to it, thematic words and common misspellings.

Numeracy



We will be developing number skills, shape, data handling and reasoning during the year in a variety of Cross-Curricular situations. Make consistent use of 'J2Blast' on Hwb to keep up with the all important times tables!

Reading books



Try to ensure that your child reads something EVERY NIGHT. Welsh and English books will be changed throughout the week and your child will be reading frequently so it's important they bring their books and their reading record to school every day. Children can change their books once they have finished and show understanding of what they have read.

Physical Education



P.E sessions are held on a Thursday afternoon. It is expected that all children change into their P.E kit before taking part. P.E kit: t-shirt (the colour of their house team) dark shorts/trousers and trainers.
